We're committed to maintaining the high level of service our clients expect and appreciate your continued support. We're excited about the season ahead and what the future holds.


















For manure spreading, we use three 18 tonne horizontal spinner type spreaders.

These machines offer exceptional spread accuracy and are designed to spread anything from semi-solids, up to farmyard manure, compost, dry shed cleanings or wet pond sludge.

Load cells on spreaders and GPS steering guidance ensure accurate rate and placement. Loading options offer either a digger or wheeled loader available depending on the task.

### **Muck Spreader Machinery.**

Built by the largest spreader hire company in the United Kingdom, Agri-Hire has been hiring machines since 1986. They began manufacturing their own spreaders in 1990 to fulfil their need for robust reliable machines that would give as near to trouble-free operation and performance to match.

Agri-Hire produces a range of spreaders from 10 to 40 tonne capacity in both vertical beater and spinner deck models with single, tandem and tri-axle variations. These are capable of spreading a wide range of materials evenly and accurately with spread widths of up to 24 metres.
